- 3. <u>Discuss and consider Advanced Funding Agreement for the McMillan Bridge,</u> <u>Replacement of or Rehabilitation of the System</u> President Moore stated there is proposition from the State of Texas concerning the repair of the lake road over the dam.

Director Hildebrandt made a motion to accept the advanced funding agreement for bridge replacement rehabilition off the State of Texas, as presented.

Warrant Johnson: "Essentially this is a one hundred thousand dollar project. We are trying to get the State to approve the funding for basically ninety percent and the water district is responsible for ten percent of it. It is important to note that this is not something that is going to go up as a fixed cost agreement. If there are any change orders, the nine thousand nine hundred and thirty-six dollars does not go up. That is a fixed cost. It is not ten percent of the total cost of the project. We are fixed at the \$9936.00. The Water District attorney and I have been through this contract extensively together and with TX DOT, he is good with it. **Director Thornton seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.**
